William is at secondary school and lives at home with his family. He has Down's Syndrome and developmental delay.

William's school is far away and this makes it difficult for his friends to come over and play. He often watches local children playing in the street on their bikes and really wants to join in. William's mother devotes a lot of time to caring for his many needs. This means she's unable to work and the family have to rely on benefits to get by.

The family's support worker contacted Independence at Home, requesting help towards the cost of a specialist tricycle, as William's family couldn't afford to pay for it.

Our grant of £380 towards a specialist trike has greatly benefited William, and also helped his family. William can now safely play with other children in his local area and join in with family trips and fun activities.
